United against Crises and Wars!

While the media and the ruling political class are constantly telling us that the recession is over and that the 'inevitable' boom will follow shortly, the opposite is true: more than ever, the rich are getting richer and the poor, poorer. In many countries, the ubiquitous policy of austerity has by now created intolerable conditions for the majority of the people. Nations in Southeast Europe and Africa are have been devastated by war and systematic violence. Ukraine, 70 years after being liberated from fascist occupations, is threatened with a major war the consequences of which are incalculable. Syria and much of the middle east have been engulfed in wars that, despite the appearance of being religious or ideological, are intended to secure access to the regions oil. People in Greece, Spain, Portugal and other countries are already fighting en masse against their own systematic impoverishment and disenfranchisement. Several countries in latin America have united against the economic dictates, with the aim of better serving the interests of the poor and working classes. In Turkey, the 2013 uprising served as a shot across the bow to the ruling class and thousands are quite literally fighting for liberty and social justice in Kurdistan. We are calling for a broad show of resistance on May the 1st, 2015, in Mainz.

- ★ The so-called “freetrade agreements” such as TTIP, TISA or CETA must be stopped. The world needs a just economic order.
- ★ Solidarity with all Refugees! The causes of displacement are created here: they lie in the military aggression against and economic plundering of other countries.
- ★ The cost of war is always paid by “regular folks”. We demand an end to all arms exports and the dissolution of NATO!
